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Introduction

Is it possible to rediscover a town you know from stories, school history lessons, or family trips? Wadowice proves that it is! It is a place where the past meets the future.

Here, at the foot of Beskid Mały, among charming streets and historic houses, extraordinary stories are hidden. It was here that Karol Wojtyła, later Pope John Paul II, was born and grew up – his tracks can be found in many places. But Wadowice is so much more!

Walking through the streets of the town, you can step back in time and feel the atmosphere of old Galicia, discover architectural gems hidden in the courtyards, or set off on one of the themed trails that lead you through unusual places and events. Do you want to know the secrets of past Wadowice artists? Or are you interested in the stories of women who changed the face of the town? Wadowice is waiting for you with open arms!

Let's not forget the flavours of Wadowice – a cream cake called 'kremówka' that became legendary, as well as local pastries and traditional dishes that will delight any palate. And if you fancy an active adventure, the surrounding mountain and pilgrimage trails will take you to places full of silence and reflection.

Wadowice is a town with a soul that has a lot to offer. It's time to discover it anew – are you ready for the adventure?



Small town, great heritage

Wadowice – a story full of twists and turns Wadowice – small, but with a great history! The first mention of the town appeared in 1327, when Duke Jan I the Scholastic gave his lands to the King of Bohemia. Even then, Wadowice already had town rights and the parish of All Saints.

Later, things went up and down – there were fires (in 1430 the town burned almost to the ground), changing rulers, and even the sale of the Zator duchy to the Polish king in 1494! Finally, in 1564, Wadowice officially became part of the Kingdom of Poland and began to develop as a Royal Free town.

In 1772, hard times came – the town came under the rule of the Austrian Empire. However, there was a silver lining – the new trade route from Lviv to Vienna led through Wadowice and gave the town a chance to grow. Offices, a court, and even military barracks were built! The 19th century saw the arrival of the Carmelites and the Pallottines, who not only built beautiful churches, but also established schools.

After World War I, Wadowice returned to Poland and became a cultural center. The town was buzzing with theatrical, literary and artistic life. In 1920, a boy who changed the course of history – Karol Wojtyła, the future Pope John Paul II – was born in one of the houses on the market square. During the interwar period, the town developed dynamically and was even visited by President Ignacy Mościcki. Unfortunately, then came the war... In 1939, the Germans incorporated Wadowice into the Third Reich, and in 1942 they created a Jewish ghetto.

In 1945, Wadowice regained its freedom and began to rebuild. New institutions, schools, and workplaces were established, and culture flourished. However, the real breakthrough came in 1978, when Karol Wojtyła became Pope. Since then, Wadowice has become known all over the world. The Pope returned home three times, and in 1984 a museum was opened in his family home.

Today, Wadowice is a place where history is intertwined with the present. Strolling through the market square, you can feel the spirit of the past, taste the famous cream cake and discover the extraordinary stories hidden within the walls of this small, but unique town.

In 2027, Wadowice will celebrate the 700th anniversary of its first mention in historical documents! It is a great opportunity to visit the town today and see history come to life again.

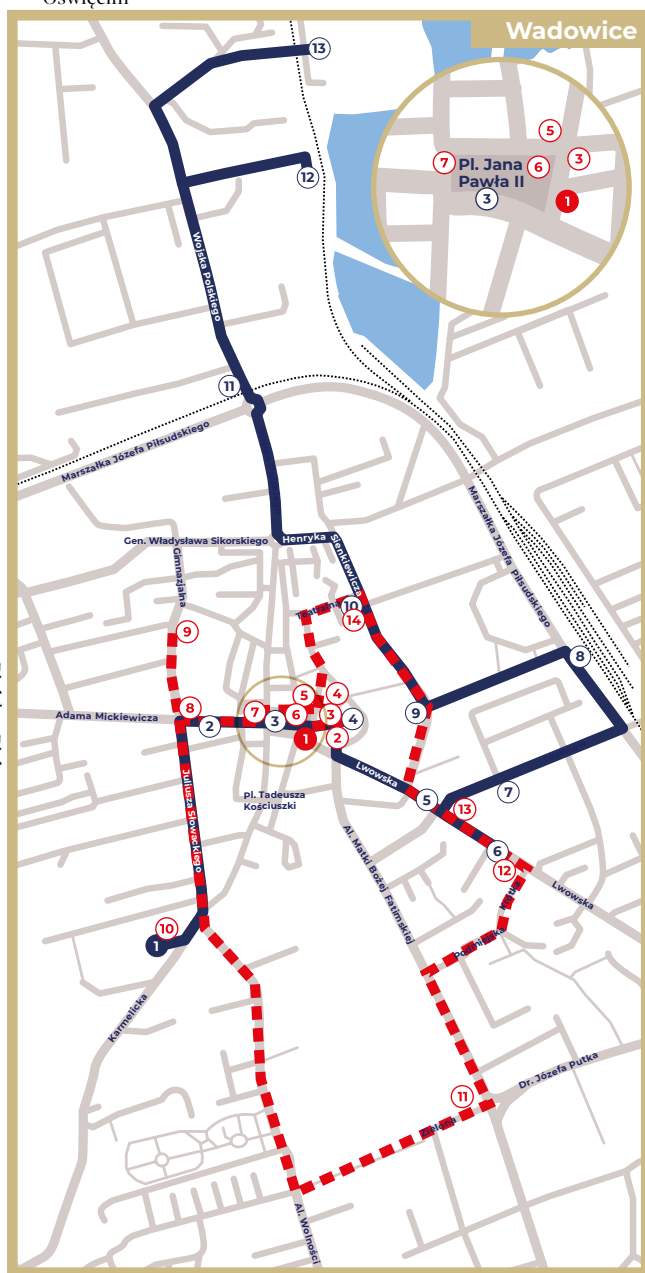

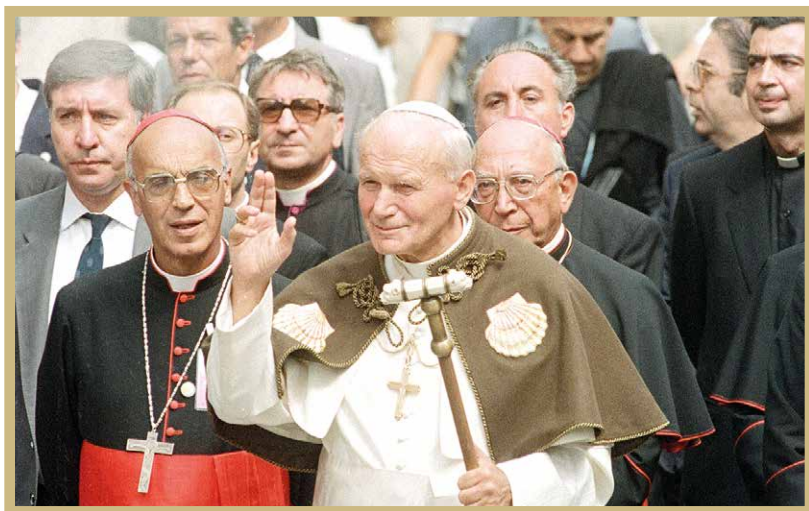

Pilgrim Trails – a Spiritual Journey Wadowice is a point on the route of unique pilgrimage routes. If you like mountain hikes and want to feel the atmosphere of places where saints and pilgrims once roamed, these trails are for you! Regardless of which route you choose, it will be an adventure and an opportunity for reflection in gorgeous nature.

Małopolska Papal Trail (Małopolski Szlak Papieski) The oldest in the area, the blue PTTK trail leads from Wadowice to the John Paul II Mountain (Groń Jana Pawła II). Karol Wojtyła often hiked along this trail to one of the popular peaks in the Beskid Mały – Leskowiec. In 2003, on the 25th anniversary of the Polish Pope's pontificate, Papal Trails in the Małopolska mountain ranges were marked out and signposted.

The Beskid Way of St. Jacob A pilgrimage route through southern Poland that joined the Camino de Santiago network in 2011. The third section leads through the Beskid Mały, Beskid Średni, Kotlina Żywiecka and Beskid Śląski, ending in Szczyrk. The section from Wadowice to Ślemień, running through Ponikiew, John Paul II Mountain (Groń Jana Pawła II), Leskowiec and Łamana Skala, partly coincides with the Małopolska Papal Trail. This is an excellent route for those looking to combine a mountain hike with spiritual reflection.

Romea Strata Wadowice lies on the route of one of the oldest pilgrimage routes to the Eternal City. Today it is a route that leads from the Baltic Sea to Italy through Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, the Czech Republic, and Austria. Along the way, there is no shortage of places where the spirit of other religions, such as Judaism or Protestantism, can be felt alongside Christianity, making the trail a meeting point for different traditions and cultures.

Wadowice – The Town Of Saints And Blessed

There are places that carry more than history – they carry the spirit of those who changed the world. Wadowice is one of them. Here, in the shadow of the Beskids hills, people were born, grew up and lived who, through their faith, courage and passion, made a mark in the history of the Church and the world.

Karol of Wadowice, who became John Paul II Karol Wojtyła was born in a small apartment by the market square on May 18, 1920. He grew up here, walking around the surrounding hills, absorbing literature and dreaming of a theater stage. Fate, however, wrote a different scenario for him – years later, he became a pope who spoke to millions, carried a message of peace, and united people of different cultures and faiths.

His pontificate began on October 16, 1978 and lasted almost 27 years. It consisted of hundreds of pilgrimages, meetings, and words that changed hearts. It was he who initiated the World Youth Day, reminding young people that they are the hope of the Church. He passed away on April 2, 2005, but Wadowice still tells his story to anyone who wishes to listen.

The Venerables Karol and Emilia Wojtyła – ordinary, yet unique It is said that holy children are raised in the lap of holy parents. The parents of John Paul II are an example that great things begin in everyday life. Emilia, warm and caring, always found time for her children despite her illness. Karol, calm and disciplined, combined work with raising his sons, showing them the importance of honesty and faith. They were not people of big words – their strength laid in simple gestures and everyday presence. Perhaps this is why their son Karol grew up into someone who changed

the world. The beatification process of the Pope's parents began on May 7, 2020 in the Basilica of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Wadowice.

Saints and blessed associated with Wadowice Marcin Wadowi-
ta's School has witnessed many extraordinary fates. Not only the young
Karol studied here, but also Józef Bilczewski (1860–1923) – a native of
nearby Wilamowice, the future archbishop of Lviv and a saint who became
famous as an eminent theologian and pastor.

The Discalced Carmelite Monastery is a place with which unique figures
were also associated.

Saint Rafal Kalinowski (1835–1907) – monk, founder and first prior of
the Wadowice monastery. Today you can look into his cell and pray in
front of the relics.

Blessed Alfons Mazurek (1891–1944) – monk, teacher, murdered by
the Nazis Germany. His bust in the local church of St. Joseph reminds
us that holiness sometimes demands the highest price.

Venerable Rev. Rudolf Warzecha (1919–1999) – a monk whose simple but loving approach to the faith made him a valued confessor and spiritual guide. His beatification process began in 2018.

Venerable Kunegunda Siwiec (1876–1955) – a lay Carmelite from the Wadowice community and a mystic whose life was filled with prayer and sacrifice. Her beatification process began in 2007.

In nearby village Klecza Dolna, there is the Collegium Marianum of the Pallottine Fathers, where the future Blessed were educated:

Blessed Józef Stanek (1916–1944) – chaplain of the Warsaw Uprising, murdered by the Nazis Germany in 1944.

Blessed Fr. Józef Jankowski (1910–1941) – priest of soldiers and civilians of Warsaw, a victim of Nazi Germany repression, murdered in KL Auschwitz.

The Flavours Of Wadowice – Tradition On A Plate

Wadowice is not only history and monuments, but also tasty traditions! Sweet, crispy, aromatic – local delicacies delight both dessert lovers and fans of savoury dishes. Did you know that the cream cake here became famous thanks to a single mention of the Pope? And the residents were nicknamed “flacorze”? Check out what you must try in Wadowice and choose your favourite flavours!

Papal cream cake – kremówka A legend which was born from the high school memory of St. John Paul II. Today, Wadowice cream cake is a real treat for the palate! Each patisserie in Wadowice has its own recipe – try and choose your favorite.



Wadowice tripe – flaczki A dish that has been on the tables of Wadowice residents for generations. For this reason, they were even called ‘flacorze’ (from Polish name of tripe, ‘flaczki’). An aromatic dish, well-known at local fairs and festivals. To this day, it is served in restaurants and at town celebrations.

‘Elitki’ – the sweet history of Wadowice Famous and popular triangular chocolate wafers called ‘Elittesse’ and named ‘Elitki’ is the work of the Wadowice confectionery factory ‘Skawa’. Wadowice sweets win hearts not only in Poland but also worldwide.

Wadowice bread – a tasty tradition for generations The town is famous for its tasty bread, baked according to traditional recipes. The oldest bakery has been operating here for 129 years! Its pastries delight both residents and tourists.



Wadowice flowing with honey Wadowice and the surrounding area are famous for the excellent honey produced by local beekeepers. It is a perfect souvenir from your visit and an opportunity to taste regional traditions. It is worth visiting the local markets or the beekeepers directly to taste the golden treasure of Wadowice!

VeloSkawa and VeloWadowice – cycling gems An increasing number of cycle paths are being built in the area, forming an integrated network of routes. There are already 15 kilometres of completed VeloSkawa and VeloWadowice paths, and further kilometres are planned.

If you are looking for a route for the whole family, the 6-kilometer VeloSkawa pedestrian and bicycle path along the Skawa River is a great choice. We start at the MKS 'Skawa' Stadium and pedal towards the dam in Świnna Poręba and Lake Mucharskie. Along the way, there is an educational path 'Nature of the Beskids', which allows you to become better acquainted with the local fauna and flora.

Pumptrack for adrenaline fans A pumptrack awaits lovers of dynamic riding, right next to the VeloSkawa path and the 'Lolek' playground. A special track for cyclists that allows you to train balance and speed without pedaling. It is safe, monitored and accessible even after dark.

Hiking in The Beskid Mały South of Wadowice is the Beskid Mały Landscape Park (Park Krajobrazowy Beskidu Małego), full of picturesque hiking trails. It is the perfect place for hiking, away from the hustle and bustle of everyday life. The mountain trails offer beautiful views of Wadowice, the Skawa river and Lake Mucharskie.

It is worth taking one of the proposed routes:

To Leskowiec and John Paul II Mountain (Groń Jana Pawła II)

The oldest and most popular trail to Leskowiec (922 m above sea level) leads from Wadowice. The tour starts at the Jana Pawła II square in Wadowice, from where the blue PTTK trail leads to the centre of the village of Ponikiew. Then the trail runs through a forest valley to the Pass under Gancarz and



further to the John Paul II Mountain (890 m above sea level) with a PTTK shelter and a chapel. You still need about 20 minutes to reach the top of Leskowiec. On the way back, follow the blue trail again. You can get from Ponikiew to Wadowice on foot or using local transport.



Around Wadowice We start from the Jana Pawła II square, take the blue PTTK trail to the T. Kościuszki square, and then take the black PTTK trail next to the Town Park. Turn into the Niwy street, pass the chapel and follow the Dąbrówka stream. From Gorzeń Dolny head towards the hill Goryczkowiec ('The Bell', 375 m above sea level), and then through the forest you reach Gorzenie

Górne. Pass the manor house of E. Zegadłowicz, turn into the National Road 28, pass the 'Old Jocker' Restaurant and reach the Jaroszwice-Zbyszów Cultural Centre. Continue along the pedestrian and bicycle route back to Lwowska street and end back at Jana Pawła II square.



To Jaroszwicka Mountain (Jaroszwicka Góra) We start the tour in Jaroszwice, behind the bridge over the Skawa River. After 1.5 hours of walking along the PTTK yellow trail, we reach the top of the Jaroszwicka Mountain (541 m above sea level). From here, the black PTTK trail leads from the summit to an asphalt road, from where we admire the Świnna Poręba Dam. We then walk

to the National Road 28 and the 'Czartak' Restaurant. From here, along the PTTK black trail, we traverse Iłowiec and reach the manor house of E. Zegadłowicz. On the way, we return to the DK28 and follow the PTTK yellow trail back to the bridge in Jaroszwice, enjoying views of Skawa and Jaroszwicka Mountain.



To Łysa Mountain (Łysa Góra) The route starts at the T. Kościuszki square in Wadowice. The blue PTTK trail leads through Zawadka to the Czesław Panczakiewicz Pass. Then, following the PTTK yellow trail, we climb Łysa Mountain (554 m above sea level) and Iłowiec Mountain (472 m above sea level). This trail connects with the PTTK black trail, which reaches the manor house of E. Zegadłowicz, and further on to the hill of Goryczkowiec

('The Bell', 375 m above sea level), from where we admire the panorama of the Beskid Mały. On the way back, you can relax in the more than 100-year-old Town Park, before returning to the T. Kościuszki square.



With The Skawa Flow Skawa is a mountain river, so kayaking down its current is a real treat for adventurers! In 2021, a unique 15-kilometer kayaking trail was created to explore its natural beauty. On the banks you will find signs that reveal all the secrets of the river – its twists and turns, its difficulties, and the surprises that await along the route. The perfect option to combine adrenaline with relaxation in the mountain nature!



Kalwaria Zebrzydowska - spiritual heart of the Małopolska region

A place where history, nature and spirituality intertwine into one extraordinary story. The Marian-Passion Sanctuary in Kalwaria Zebrzydowska is not only a monastery, but also a space full of tradition and reverie, hidden among the Beskids hills.

The sanctuary, built in the 17th century on the model of Jerusalem, allows you to move to paths symbolically recreating the Way of the Passion of the Lord. Wandering along the Calvary paths, you can see about 40 historic chapels and churches, each of which has its own history. The baroque Basilica of Our Lady of the Angels houses the miraculous image of Our Lady of Calvary, attracting pilgrims from all over the world.

Due to its uniqueness, the sanctuary was inscribed on the prestigious UNESCO World Heritage List in 1999.

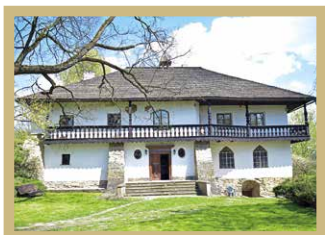

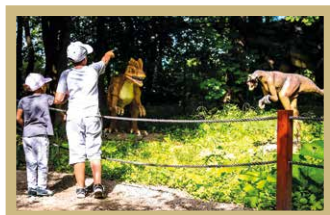
