

## **Regulations for the use of baggage lockers in the Culture Station building**

- 1.** These Regulations describe the rules of the use of baggage lockers located in the Culture Station building (Piłsudskiego 10, 34-100 Wadowice), hereinafter "Culture Station."
- 2.** The entity managing the Culture Station on behalf of the Wadowice city is the Wadowice Cultural Center of Marcin Wadowita located at Teatralna 1 in Wadowice, hereinafter "Manager."
- 3.** People who wish to use the baggage lockers are required to get acquainted with the Regulations before using the lockers.
- 4.** Using the baggage lockers is equal to accepting the Regulations.
- 5.** The baggage lockers room is monitored.
- 6.** The Manager is the administrator of the personal data collected from the video surveillance and the data included in the emergency locker opening protocol.
- 7.** The Manager provides self-service lockers for baggage storage for travelers.
- 8.** The lockers may be used as storage only for the baggage of travelers taking a train with a stop at the Culture Station.
- 9.** The baggage lockers are available for the users 6:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m., 7 days a week.
- 10.** The use of the baggage lockers is free.
- 11.** Items larger than the size of the baggage lockers cannot be stored.
- 12.** The baggage lockers are not monitored directly, and the Manager does not supervise the items in the baggage locker, nor is the Manager responsible for the items left in the locker or stolen by any third parties.
- 13.** Items other than hand baggage are not allowed to be stored in the baggage lockers, in particular:
  - a)** flammables and explosives (including weapons), corrosives, toxic substances or other materials which may be hazardous to third parties,
  - b)** materials and substances which spoil easily or have an unpleasant odor,
  - c)** living animals,
  - d)** dead animals, unless they have been processed in a way that stops the decay process, and items which are exposed to the decay process,
  - e)** narcotic and addictive substances which are illegal to possess and distribute according to the law,
  - f)** items which are illegal to possess according to the law,
  - g)** valuable and precious items, i.e., money, documents, valuables, including jewelry and its surrogates (precious stones, pearls, processed and unprocessed precious metals), furs and other leather products, electronic equipment (including mobile phones, cameras, laptops, computers, power banks, etc.)
- 14.** In the case of items left in the lockers for over 1 day, rules on lost and found items from 27 January 2023 apply (Dziennik Ustaw [Journal of Laws] 2023, item 501).
- 15.** The Manager has the right to open a locker if the baggage is left in it for over 1 day or if items from point 13 are suspected of being stored in the locker.
- 16.** If the key to the locker is lost, a Culture Station staff member performs an emergency opening of the baggage locker.
  - a)** The person who reports and is meant to collect items/baggage from the locker is required to describe the content of the baggage and confirm the collection in the locker opening protocol.
  - b)** The Culture Station staff member issuing the items is required to be shown an identity document by the person meant to collect the items from the locker, and in the case of refusal to show an identity document, the staff member is required to abandon the emergency locker opening procedure.
  - c)** The person issuing the items verifies the consistency of the description of the items with the protocol.
- 17.** These Regulations are made public by posting them above the baggage lockers.
- 18.** The publication of the Regulations described in point 17 is equal to providing the second party with the model contract mentioned in article 384 of the Civil Code.
- 19.** Situations not regulated by these Regulations are regulated by the Civil Code and other specific provisions.
