



# Wadowice!



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Welcome to Wadowice, the town of St. John Paul II – the patron of the family! Wadowice is located in a picturesque valley filled with attractions and situated between the hills of the Wieliczka Foothills (Pogórze Wielickie) and the mountain ranges of Little Beskids (Beskid Mały), which encourages spending time with friends and family in an active and interesting manner. In this brochure you will find suggestions for both the youngest tourists and serious teenagers. They include open air activities, live history lessons, and slow-life laziness! We invite you to Wadowice, the hometown of Karol Wojtyła – St. John Paul II, to spend family time in our town and its immediate vicinity.

The historic centre of Wadowice is located on the forks of the mountain river Skawa and the Choczenka stream, at an altitude of approx. 270 m above sea level. Distance from Wadowice to Cracow, the capital of the voivodeship is only 50 km! GPS coordinates: N: 49° 53′ 8″ E: 19° 29′ 28″.

### If the weather is nice, then go to the mountains....

Did you know that you can go to the nearby mountains straight from Wadowice? The renowned Czesław Panczakiewicz trail leads from the town centre to the famous Leskowiec (918 m above sea level) and the Mountain of John Paul II (Groń Jana Pawła II)! You can shorten the walking distance by driving to Ponikiew.

### PTTK blue trail:

Ponikiew – Mountain of John Paul II (Groń Jana Pawła II) and Leskowiec (6.2 km, 598 m elevation difference, approx. 2 hours walk in one direction)

Route: Ponikiew - Gancarz Pass (Przełęcz pod Gancarzem) - Mountain of John Paul II (Groń Jana Pawła II, 890 m above sea level) - Leskowiec Mountain Hostel - Leskowiec (918 m above sea level).



#### .... or to the lake...

The crown of the dam in Świnna Poręba, which forms the picturesque **Mucharskie Lake (Jezioro Mucharskie)**, is located less than 6 km south of Wadowice! Along its bank you can find marinas where it is possible to rent water equipment or sun loungers.

### ... or to the river!

**Skawa** despite being a mountain river, is great for canoeing. While the Lower Skawa Valley (*Dolina Dolnej Skawy*) is an area of special protection for water and marsh birds (Natura 2000), where it is possible to go on an ornithological trip.

# Karol Wojtyła's Foot Trail through Wadowice!

In our town you can discover many locations connected to Karol Wojtyła – Pope John Paul II! This will be possible thanks to the Karol Wojtyła's Foot Trail, where you will find, for example, the family home, schools, or a building of a former famous patisserie. It is best to navigate the Trail using the multimedia app, in which young Karol serves as the guide 'in person'. All it takes is to get close to one of the points so that the application triggers a voice-over concerning the history of a given place. Communication between individual places is facilitated by a map that shows their location. The application is characterized by a clear graphic design, simple, intuitive navigation, and support for 6 languages. It can be downloaded to mobile devices for free from Google Play and the App Store.



### Family Home of Karol Wojtyła – St. John Paul II



Karol Wojtyła, later pope and Saint John Paul II was born in this tenement house on 18 May 1920, and lived there until 1938. Since 1984, the building houses a biographical museum dedicated to him.





During the interwar period, a Hygienic Dairy was located here. After the death of Emilia, the mother of the future pope, young Karol dined with his father here. Currently, the building is the seat of the Tourist Information Centre and the Town Museum.

### The parish church of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary



In this church, the future pope was baptized, received the First Holy Eucharist and was Confirmed. He also served here as an altar boy. In 2011, his relics were placed in a chapel dedicated to St. John Paul II.

### 4) Catholic House



Theatre plays were staged here under the direction of Fr. E. Zacher. During this period, Karol made his debut as a co-director of the 'Undivine Comedy'. Currently, the theatre hall is used by the Museum of the Holy Father John Paul II Family Home.

#### (5) Former Marcin Wadowita Primary School



Karol began his education at this school in 1926. That's where he found out about his mother's death. The ground floor of the building was occupied by the offices of the Municipal Office, and classrooms were located on the upper floors. Currently, the building serves as the Municipal Office.

### 6 Former Marshal Józef Piłsudski Square – Market Square




The square constituted the centre of Karo-I's life. His family home, parish church, and public school were all located here. After his election as pope, it became a meeting place for the residents of Wadowice. Currently, the square's pavement is adorned by plaques commemorating his pilgrimages.

### Former Karol Hagenhuber Confectionery



After graduating from high school, students went to the patisserie to celebrate this event. Graduates from the pope's year also went to get cream cakes in the patisserie, which was located in this building. Following this, local pastry chefs decided to serve their own versions of this popular pastry.





(8) Former Marcin Wadowita School **Humanities Secondary School** 

This classic school was founded in 1866 and had many outstanding graduates over the years, including Karol and Edmund Wojtyła. Currently, the building is occupied by M. Wadowita General High School No. 1. In front of the school we can find a bench of its greatest graduate - Karol Wojtyła.



**Synagogue in Wadowice** 

Karol grew up in an atmosphere of two cultures and religions. His schoolmates included Jews, and Jerzy Kluger was one of his close friends. In 1936, Karol was invited by Jerzy's father to a special concert held in the synagogue. That is when the future pope first crossed the threshold of a temple of a different religion. In the autumn of 1939, this synagogue was burned down by the Germans. Currently, there is a kindergarten in this place.



**Monastery of the Barefoot Carmelite Fathers** 

This is where Karol accepted the scapular. He often went with his father to the church of St. Joseph at this monastery. In 2004, the painting of St. Joseph in the main altar was decorated with the Ring of the Fisherman of the Holy Father, and the church received the title of the Sanctuary of St. Joseph.



**Church of St. Peter the Apostle** 

This church was built as a votive offering for the election of Cardinal Wojtyła to the See of St. Peter and saving him from an assassination attempt. The construction was carried out by the residents of Wadowice at the turn of the 1980s. Later, an outdoor Way of the Cross was built at the back of the complex.



) Military barracks

The barracks building were built in the first half of the 19th century and it is a typical monument of military construction of the former Austrian Partition. In these barracks, Karol Wojtyła Sr., father of St. John Paul II, began his military career.



House of Divine Providence of the Congregation of the sisters of the Holy Family of Nazareth Soon after settling in Wadowice, Nazareth Sisters opened a day care for children. Along with his friends, Karol was invited there by the sisters, and



that is where he participated in classes and games organized for the voungest. Currently, this is where the children's community centre is located.

14) Former building of the 'Sokół' **Gymnastic Society** 

In 1887, the seat of the 'Sokół' Gymnastic Society was established here, along with a theatre complex. As a school student, Karol actively participated in the school theatre club along with female school students. The first joint performance was the adaptation of 'Sobótka' by J. Kochanowski. Currently, the former 'Sokół' building houses the Wadowice Cultural Centre.



# 'Aren't we all children of one God?' The story of an extraordinary friendship!

As always, Karol was half an hour ahead of schedule. Since his birth, he lived next door to the church and all he had to do was run those few meters from his door to reach it. However, since he became an altar boy, he has become exceptionally punctual, as taught by his father, also named Karol. On that day, he got up much earlier than usual. In addition to service during the morning mass, what required prior preparation, today he also waited for an information that could have shaped his future. On that day, the famous Wadowice Humanities Secondary School was supposed to announce a list of newly admitted students! Karol took the initial exams last week, and since then has been anxiously awaiting the good news. In fact, he wasn't waiting alone, because Karol applied together with his best friend from primary school, Jurek Kluger, who was the son of the chairman of the Wadowice Jewish Community. This meant he was a Jew himself, and Karol was a Catholic. However, this didn't bother the boys at all and did not prevent them from playing, having fun and studying together. Therefore, on that day, Jurek waited for Karol by the church and after the morning mass boys were supposed to see whether they were admitted to their dream school. However, this time the mass was very long and the impatient Jurek, wanting to surprise his colleague, ran himself to check the results. When he returned with the good news that they both got accepted, the mass was still in progress. Without thinking much, he ran into the church building, heading towards the side altar where Karol was serving as an altar boy, in order to give him the good news. Unfortunately, halfway through an older woman stopped him, asking: 'Aren't you the son of the chairman of the Jewish Community? Therefore, you should not enter the church!' Karol saw the entire situation. He approached them and decided to answer for Jurek, saying 'Why? Aren't we all children of one God?' Such a mature response from a ten-year-old boy surprised the woman who returned to the bench without saying anything. After leaving the temple, the boys went together to see the lists of newly admitted students. Karol and Jurek spent the following years in the School together, nurturing their friendship. Their paths were separated during the tragic events of World War II, when almost the entire Kluger family was killed. Friends met again many years later, when Karol was already a cardinal, and Jurek settled permanently in Rome. Despite differences in terms of faith, they remained faithful to their childhood friendships.



### Papal cream cake - kremówka



If you like spending time in the kitchen, we invite you to prepare a homemade cream cake!

Did you know that the tradition of producing cream cakes in Wadowice dates back to the 1930s? That is when a Viennese pastry chef, Karol Hagenhuber, who came from Brzesko, brought the cake's secret to the Skawa river. The new dessert became a favourite snack for the residents of Wadowice, and students celebrated graduation by eating cream cakes. Also the future pope, Karol Wojtyła, followed this tradition and after graduation, together with his colleagues went to get cream cakes!

### Can you bake a cream cake on your own? Good Luck!

### **INGREDIENTS: Puff pastry:**







250 grams of butter 1 egg yolk





a pinch of salt ½ cup of water



250 grams of flour

### Whipped cream:



½ litre of double cream



2 tablespoons of powdered sugar



1 packet of vanilla sugar

### Vanilla cream:



2 tablespoons of butter



3/4 cup sugar



2 cups milk



1 packet of vanilla sugar



½ cup wheat flour



3 eggs



3 egg yolks

### **PREPARATION:**

#### Vanilla cream:



into the milk, and bring it to a boil.



Mix the vanilla sugar Add sugar, whole eggs and egg yolks to the flour, mix thoroughly.



Pour the boiling milk in, stirring constantly, and boil.



After completely cooling, add the butter and stir until a uniform mass is obtained

#### Whipped cream: **Puff pastry:**



Beat the chilled cream with sugar and vanilla sugar into a fluffy consistency.



Knead the butter together with 1/5 of the flour, form a cube and chill.



Use the remaining flour, egg yolk, water, and a pinch of salt to knead a dough and chill it for approx. 20 minutes.



Roll out the cold dough.



Place the cube of butter and flour in the middle, cover with opposite sides of the dough and roll out to approx. 2 cm.



Fold the opposite sides inwards and then in half and roll out. Repeat the envelope folding four times, and after each folding place the dough for 15-20 minutes in the refrigerator.



Roll out to a thickness of approx. 0.5 cm and place it on a baking sheet.



Bake at 200°C to a light brown colour.

### 12. Combining all parts of the cake:

Cut the baked puff pastry into two equal parts, apply the vanilla cream, then a layer of whipped cream to one half. Cover it with the other half of the pastry, and sprinkle with powdered sugar.





The 16th-century castle surroundings include a well-maintained park with a Gardener's Hut.

### Do you know where the famous Servant of God, Father Rudolf Warzecha, comes from?

You will find out at the Regional Museum in Bachowice.

The facility collects items and exhibits commemorating three individuals closely tied to these areas and history, namely: Father Prelate Fr. Gołba – builder of the parish church, but also a devoted social worker supporting the development of education, agriculture, and crafts, Fr. Stefczyk, PhD – a pioneer of the Polish cooperative movement, founder of the Cooperative Savings and Credit Funds, long-term collaborator of Father Fr. Gołba, and the Servant of God Father R. Warzecha. Museum offers guided tours only.

### In our region, the history is inscribed upon the landscape itself. Just look around!

In Małopolska Region (Województwo Małopolskie), wood has been used as a building material for centuries.

In the vicinity of Wadowice one can come across unique wooden churches, including St. Erasmus Church in Barwald Dolny, the Transfiguration of the Lord Church in Radocza or the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church in Woźniki, the Rzym Inn in Sucha Beskidzka, and unique wooden buildings of Lanckorona. These facilities are located on the The Wooden Architecture Route in Małopolska Region.

### The Church of St. Erasmus in Barwald Dolny

built the 2nd half of 18th century, apart from the tower, which is a remnant of the previous church from the 16th century. Inside the temple, it is worth paying attention to a chancel beam with a late-Gothic crucifix, a stone Baroque baptismal font, Rococo organs from 1770, and a unique painting of Madonna with a pear from the 16th century.



### Are you looking for monuments inducted to the World Heritage UNESCO? Only in Małopolska Region!

In our immediate vicinity, you will discover a UNESCO treasure in the nearby Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, where the Passion-Marian Sanctuary in Kalwaria Zebrzydowska – the Monastery of Bernardine Fathers is located. A globally unique architectural and park design from the 17th century was modelled after the Road to the Calvary in Jerusalem. Inside the basilica there is a wonderful painting of Our Lady of Kalwaria. The cloister complex consists of a Baroque basilica, a monastery, and Calvary paths located in the picturesque Beskid landscape.

### Can a wooden manor house also be a fortification? You will find the answer in the 17th-century Manor in Stryszów!

This is a unique example of the old manorial architecture. The interior of the manor house depicts the home of a moderately wealthy nobleman from the 19th century, equipped with furniture from Vienna and Paris.

in Lanckorona is located in one of several wooden buildings that survived the fire of 1869. The facility's collection includes exhibits from excavations in the Lanckorona castle, as well as everyday objects and folk crafts from the beginning of the 20th century. Part of the exhibition is devoted to the Bar Confederation, as the Lanckorona castle was a major stronghold of the confederates.

### The Museum Chamber in Kalwaria Zebrzydowska

run by the Society of Friends of Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, collects objects thematically related to the history of the Kalwaria land, traditions of crafts, and the works of local artists. At the chamber it is possible to see the historical furniture made by carpenters from Kalwaria, old photographs and postcards from Kalwaria, Furniture Fair posters, and historical artifacts of everyday use.

### In the Franciszek Suknarowski Gallery

in Wadowice, you can familiarize yourself with the artistic achievements of this sculptor and painter from Wadowice. In his youth, Suknarowski was associated with the local circle of artists, including W. Bałys or E. Zegadłowicz. His artistic achievements include many monuments, paintings, woodcuts, or medals. owes its name to Wincenty Bałys, a sculptor born in Tomice. The gallery is a unique place, presenting the works of local artists. It is located in an old, renovated wooden hut from 1866, where agricultural tools from the last century are exhibited. Here, it is possible to not only admire, but



also to purchase oil paintings, watercolours, sculptures, and ceramics. It is also possible to participate in pottery and painting workshops.

# Who was the famous Wadowita or how Marcin Kępka became a Professor!

A long time ago, when Poland was still ruled by kings in Cracow, and their reign was so good and beneficial that this time was called the Golden Age, in the Royal Town of Wadowice lived little Marcin Kepka. However, he was not an ordinary boy like all others. Not only because his father was a town councilman able to decide the fate of the town with other council members, but because he was always happy to help at home! In addition to making his bed and school activities, Marcin's daily duties included helping with the family farm. Marcin's parents, Mr. and Mrs. Kepka, raised chickens, geese, ducks, and a few cows. However, the pigs proved the biggest challenge for everyone! Despite a special enclosure, it was difficult to handle them. This task was often assigned to Marcin as the eldest of the siblings. The boy was quite bored with these animals, because pigs only wanted to roll in the mud, as pigs do... That is why Marcin came up with the idea to combine doing homework, which he usually did immediately after school, with tending to the pigs. He thought that since a good fence was built, nothing would happen if he sat under the nearby apple tree for a while and did his homework. However, the assignment turned out to be so engaging that he didn't even notice when all the animals disappeared. He sprang to his feet and began to look for them all over the town. Unfortunately, he did not find a single pig... It was getting late, and he was reluctant to return home. His worried parents were waiting for him at the doorstep. It turned out that the pigs had already returned home, and Marcin was still gone! Mr. and Mrs. Kepka were very happy with their son returning home. Marcin himself apologized for his behaviour and never neglected his duties at home or at school. Over time, he turned out to be the best student in school and as a reward for his good grades he was admitted to the best university! He liked it so much that he stayed in Cracow for good. As a professor, Marcin Kepka became a teacher at the Jagiellonian University, and to commemorate his roots in Wadowice, he was eventually called Wadowita! He himself often joked that if it wasn't for those pigs, he wouldn't have become a scholar. Because it was this event that taught him that you always have to diligently perform all your duties, even the most boring ones, like pig herding.

# Seek the natural treasures of the region!

**Wadowice**, like many other towns in Poland and Europe, was located by a river. Skawa is a 96-km long tributary of the Vistula River! Its spring consists in several streams in Beskid Żywiecki, and its mouth to the Vistula (Wisła) is located near Zator. It is a river with a simple, canal bed. Along with the surrounding riverside nature, it constitutes one of the riches of Wadowice and its surroundings. It is perfect for aficionados of canoeing, fishing, and nature! We encourage you to discover the richness of nature in our region with your families.



If you want to rest on the river bank in Wadowice with your families, it is worth going to the area of the road bridge on the Skawa river, to the so-called Venice (Wenecja). There is a recreational area, where everyone will find something for themselves, be it a playground for children, an outdoor gym or beach volleyball courts. During the summer season, it is a place where outdoor events are often organized.

# Did you know that the Lower Skawa Valley (Dolina Dolnej Skawy) is a protected area?

In terms of Natura 2000, this is an area of special protection for water and marsh birds. This land covers an area of 7081.7 ha and lies in the Oświęcim Basin (Kotlina Oświęcimska) and the Western Beskid Foothills (Pogórze Zachodniobeskidzkie). You can learn more during e.g., an ornithological tour of the pond complex Przeręb.



### Did you know that Wadowice has been developing a network of bicycle routes for several years now?

We particularly recommend a 6 km walking and cycling route along the Skawa River, along which the 'Nature of Beskidy' ('Przyroda Beskidów') educational path is located. The route goes from the MKS Skawa Stadium (ul. Błonie 1) in the direction of Jaroszowice – Zbywaczówka. In the middle of the route it is possible to stop at the Cultural Centre in Jaroszowice-Zbywaczówka, where a shelter for cyclists and a beach volleyball court are located. Two kilometres further, before the Ponikiewka stream, the route turns left and goes near the Skawa riverbed, encircling Zbywaczówka. After reaching the bridge on the river, turn left and reach the bike path leading back towards the stadium.

### How to actively spend time with your family in the open air? We're going to the mountains together!

Wadowice is located in an exceptionally picturesque region of the Małopolska Region (Województwo Małopolskie). The wide ranges of Little Beskids (Beskid Mały) stretch to the south of the town, forming the Little Beskids Landscape Park (Park Krajobrazowy Beskidu Małego). Either with the entire family or individually, you can enjoy contact with nature away from the rush of everyday life. Mountain trails offer a view of, e.g., Wadowice, Skawa River or Mucharskie Lake (Jezioro Mucharskie). The best way to get to know the eastern part of Little Beskids is to set off on one of the proposed tourist routes.

### To Leskowiec (918 m above sea level) from the village of Rzyki

A short walk to the top of Leskowiec is a great opportunity to introduce your child to Little Beskids (Beskid Mały). The black PTTK trail leads from the village of Rzyki (Jagódka or Mydlarze settlement) mainly through the forest, often leading through stony ground, to finally take hikers to the ridge and reward them with beautiful views. The trail is quite steep, but even very young children will manage to get through. From the top you can go down to the PTTK Leskowiec mountain hostel (890 m above sea level) to rest and eat well.

### Around Wadowice in two and a half hours! (circa 6.8 km)

We begin our journey at John Paul II Square (pl. Jana Pawła II), from where we follow the blue PTTK trail towards the Kościuszko Square. Then we follow ul. Karmelicka up, and then at the intersection we turn into the black PTTK trail to Aleja Wolności. We pass the Town Park and go down this street. At the roundabout, turn right into ul. Niwy, and after few minutes of walking enter a side street on the left. We pass a brick chapel and immediately beyond it we turn left and follow the Dąbrówka stream. We reach ul. Szkolna, and quickly turn right, following through Gorzeń Dolny towards the top of Goryczkowiec (373 m above sea level), also collo-



quially referred to as the 'Bell' ('Dzwonek'). After reaching it, we pass by a Loreto chapel and continue along the edge of the forest to enter it soon. Then the trail leads down the slope and reaches Gorzeń Górny. We leave the black trail and pass the Emil Zegadłowicz Manor on the right. Through a narrow road, surrounded by houses, we head towards the main road (DK 28). We reach a chapel on the main road, where we turn right and head towards the Old Jocker Restaurant, and carefully cross the DK28 road. Then we head to the Jaroszowice-Zbywaczówka Cultural Centre, where we enter the walking and cycling route. Then we turn left and head towards the town centre. After reaching the end of the route, we enter ul. Błonie, and then turn into ul. Lwowska, which takes us to the John Paul II Square.

### Or perhaps an expedition in search of the Komoniecki Cave...

The Komoniecki Cave (Grota Komonieckiego) has an area of 115 m2, and is located in the eastern part of Beskid Mały, at an altitude of 700 meters above sea level, slightly southeast of Łamana Skała. There is no trail leading there, so reaching the cave requires some attention, but it is worth visiting, because it is a charming place. Near the cave it is possible to admire the highest waterfall in Beskid Mały - the Dusica Waterfall. The cave's beauty is enriched by the Dusica stream, which flows down the rock plate, creating beautiful ice forms during the winter. Also in winter, it is possible to see stalactites and stalagmites inside the cave, while during the summer, the waters of the stream provide a pleasant refreshment. You can reach there by e.g., following the green PTTK trail from Targoszów, going to Czarna Góra, behind which you need to go off the trail to reach the cave after about 15 minutes of going down a relatively steep descent. From here, it is only a few dozen meters down to the Dusica waterfall. A few dozen meters before the Cave there is a sign informing that the cave is near. Going from Targoszów to the waterfall takes about 2 hours, first up a steep hill, and then down a similarly steep slope.




### ... or a walk along a nature path?

**The Czarny Groń path** (Ścieżka Czarny Groń, approx. 7.5 km) - along the path there are 11 educational boards with information about local fauna and flora, history of the region, architecture, geology, and nature protection. It begins under the "Czarny Groń" resort in Rzyki and leads through the valley of the Pracica stream, and then through the peaks of Smrekowica, Łamana Skała, and Potrójna back to Rzyki. It presents diverse forest ecosystems and interesting rock forms.

**Rock Trail** (Szlak Skałek, approx. 11.5 km) marked as the PTTK green trail. Its beginning and end are located in Targoszów. It links the Czarna Góra, Smrekowica and Na Beskidzie peaks, and passes through the valley of the Targoszówka stream. Along the trail it is possible to admire many rock formations chiefly composed of sandstones and conglomerates.

Chapel Trail (Szlak Kapliczek, approx. 20 km) marked as the yellow PTTK trail. It only partially runs through the area of the Beskid Mały Landscape Park. It connects the Discalced Carmelites Monastery in Przysłop in Beskid Żywiecki and a chapel at the Mountain of John Paul II (Groń Jana Pawła II).

### Tradition with modernity? It's just a 100-year-old Town Park in Wadowice!

Since the beginning of its existence, it was created for the recreation of the town's residents, including the youngest ones. Places for children's playgrounds were designated as early as in 1912. Currently, the Town Park includes two playgrounds and outdoor gyms for young people and adults. In the nooks and crannies of the park, you can also find valuable specimens of trees, secluded squares, a mound dedicated to A. Mickiewicz, gazebos, and even an overlook footbridge with a telescope. Sensory devices and educational nature paths in the Park provide educational entertainment for the youngest. The Town Park is a safe place to spend time with the entire family and away from onerous transport routes. In the villa at the entrance to the Park there is a popular cafe. During the holiday season, it is possible to watch free open-air film screenings and listen to concerts.

### Shared relaxation at a graduation tower with a unique microclimate!

It is a natural inhaler with healing and relaxing properties. The graduation tower is a structure made of wood and blackthorn. It owes its beneficial effect to brines, i.e., natural mineral waters containing large amounts of sodium ions. Flowing down the vertical walls, water forms an aerosol that is rich in salts and possesses medicinal properties. It is estimated that an approximately one-hour session near a graduation tower provides health benefits similar to those of spending three days by the sea. Around the graduation tower there are benches, modern lighting, parking spaces for bicycles, a green zone, and a scenic overlook.

# On the trail of Falcons from Wadowice - a tourist game for the entire family

**History:** The 'Sokół' (Falcon) Gymnastic Society became a symbol of social activity for the residents of Wadowice. In 1887, the residents of Wadowice formed their own organization and in a few years they built a magnificent building intended for its activities. The aim of the association was to promote physical education and conduct educational activities. Students from local schools, including high school students, attended classes organized at 'Sokół'. In addition to gymnastics classes, there was an option to join an amateur drama club, choir or a cycling, fencing, tennis, and bowling sections. Since the beginning of the 1890s, members of 'Sokół' have been also organizing an ice rink during the winter. Another important area of activity were also rifle shooting classes. In time, 'Sokół' was headed by Mieczysław W. Gedl, a Viennese by birth, a resident of Wadowice by choice. On his initiative, the 'Sokolnia' construction committee was established, and he was elected director for his merits.

The Wadowice 'Sokół' was the westernmost unit in Galicia. It was established as the thirteenth unit after the founding of the native 'Sokół' in Lviv, and operated until 1949 when it was recognized as an organization opposing the prevailing communist regime. 'Sokół' was reborn in 1990. In 1997, an honorary membership of the Wadowice 'Sokół' unit was bestowed upon the Pope John Paul II.

**Storyline:** On the occasion of the 60th anniversary of founding the 'Sokół' in Lviv, on 2nd June 1927, the route of the Warsaw – Lviv relay went through Wadowice. The relay went from Katowice, through Tychy, Czechowice-Dziedzice, Bielsko-Biała, Kęty, Wadowice, Skawina, to Cracow. The 1560 km run was attended by a total of 4 thousand runners. The members of 'Sokół' from Wadowice secured the course of the run. You can play the roles of the relay's participants and discover what made them so eager to join the ranks of this association.




#### **Municipal Office in Wadowice**

It was in this building, in the Session Hall of the Wadowice Town Council, that the founding meeting of the Wadowice 'Sokół' had taken place. It was held on 20th May 1887, at the invitation of the mayor Ignacy Brosig. The majority of the 31 founding members consisted of lawyers and candidates for this profession. Establishing a local branch of the Lviv Gymna-

stic Society 'Sokół' in Wadowice was proposed by Fryderyk Lachner, a high school professor, and Karol Młodzik, an advocate trainee. The Management Board of the Society consisted of the General Assembly and the Department, to which a chairman, deputy-chairman, five members, and their two deputies were elected.

#### **Town Museum and Tourist Information**

In 1900, a decision was made to adopt a new statute of 'Sokół', in which it was decided to make the Society independent. Wadowice 'Sokół' ceased to be a branch of Lviv's structures and became the 'Sokół' Polish Gymnastic Society based in Wadowice. At that point, the ceremonial outfit of the members was also determined. It consisted of a cap decorated

with a falcon feather fitted with a white and crimson<sup>1</sup> cockade and a silver badge representing a falcon in flight, a Kościuszko czamara<sup>2</sup> with galloons, an amaranth



shirt<sup>1</sup>, sirwals<sup>2</sup>, belt, black boots, white and coral gloves, and a dark coat. A badge with the name of the registered office of the Society (Wadowice) is also attached to the breast of czamara. Some elements of the outfit can be admired in our Town Museum.



#### **Wadowice Cultural Centre**

The construction of the TG 'Sokół' seat was completed as early as in 1889. The solemn dedication of the new seat under the name of Our Lady (patroness of 'Sokół' members) was performed by Father Adam Zając. The building was erected in the area by the Choczenka River, on the municipal grounds referred to as the 'gymnastic garden'. However, the new building

proved to be insufficient for the needs of the association, and in the same year it was reconstructed according to a conceptual work by the excellent architect Teodor Talowski. The adaptation works were finished in 1892. The person particularly involved in establishing the seat of 'Sokół' was a doctor and town councillor Mieczysław Gedl. In recognition of his merits, he was elected Director of the Society's Department. In the passage leading to the main hall on the ground floor it is possible to see a commemorative plaque dedicated to him. Currently, the former 'Sokół' building, rebuilt in 1953-1958, houses the Wadowice Cultural Centre.

#### Classicist tenement house designed by I. Sowiński

Before the outbreak of World War I, this building housed, among others, the headquarters of the Stefan Żółkiewski First Scout Troop organized by the School of Humanities. The troop consisted of 9 patrols made up of more than 80 athletic and uniformed young people. It was also where the first female scouting troop in the county operated, having

been founded in 1913. A year earlier, the so-called Stefan Żółkiewski Wild Scout Troop went under the management of 'Sokół' in Wadowice. Its adaptation to the society's structures was commissioned to a high school drawing teacher, Alfred Beer. During World War I, trained scouts from this Troop took part in combat, as a part of e.g., 2nd Brigade of Polish Legions.

### Marcin Wadowita General High School No. 1

In 1866, after more than 30 years of efforts, the Wadowice School of Humanities finally opened its doors. The quality of education was very high, as evidenced by the careers of the graduates from the Galician times, such as St. Józef Biba Bilczewski, Gen. Walerian Czumia, Prof. Stanisław Witkowski, and the author Emil Zegadłowicz, to name only a few.

The school's students willingly attended classes organized at 'Sokół'. In the 'Sokolnia' gymnastics hall, physical education classes were also available for young people from all schools in Wadowice. The Student Shooting Club operated under the care of the Wadowice 'Sokół', allowing high school students to participate in shooting practice. After the classes have been officially suspended, the students continued to train in the Sokół Field Teams and in branches of the Shooting Association. As a result, numerous students and graduates eventually joined the Polish Legions. Currently, the building is occupied by Marcin Wadowita General High School No. 1, which continues the traditions of its predecessor.

# Sanctuary of St. Joseph - Monastery of the Barefoot Carmelite Fathers

In 1909, the Austrian government approved the establishment of rifle clubs. Therefore, 'Sokół' shifted the priority of activities from gymnastic exercises to military training. The authorities issued an order to create Permanent Field Teams. At the time of departure to the front, the battalion

in Wadowice numbered 530 people. One of the initiators of Wadowice Carmel construction was Father Józef Rybka. On 8th of September 1914, he gave a passionate, patriotic speech to several hundred members of the 'Sokół' Gymnastic Society, who then went to Bochnia to join the Polish Legions. Members of 'Sokół' from Wadowice fought in the First World War, mainly as a part of the 3rd Regiment of the 2nd Brigade of Polish Legions, commonly known as 'Carpathian Iron Brigade', under the command of Gen. Karol Durski-Trzaska and later under Col. Józef Haller.


#### **Adam Mickiewicz Town Park**

The Town Park has been established in 1905-1912, in the area called Górnica. In 1907 the park went under the care of the Society for the Beautification of the Town of Wadowice and Surroundings (Towarzystwo Upiększania Miasta Wadowic i Okolicy - TUMWiO). In the years 1913-1914, a wooden villa called the 'Górnica' Shelter was built for participants of events

held in the park. Currently, it houses a restaurant. During the interwar period, the Town Park flourished and has been expanded by the addition of gazebos, a veranda by the shelter, and a band shell, in which the orchestra of the 12th Infantry Regiment of the Wadowice Land performed during summer weekends. The park also hosted festivals and theatre performances. In 1934, the park was enriched with a pond and a fountain in connection with the construction of the municipal water supply. A mound (317 m above sea level) was also erected using the soil excavated during the construction of an equalizing tank. At its top, a commemorative board was placed with a dedication for Adam Mickiewicz. After the end of World War II, the activity of TUMWiO came to an end with the death of its last president, Czesław Panczakiewicz, who also was a member of 'Sokół'. The Park's current appearance is a result of the revitalization carried out in 2018-2019.


